

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BAMBERG BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 2005 AT 5:15 P.M. AT CITY HALL. MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Bob Clary and Commissioner Dr. Marion Dwight. MANAGER: Bruce Ellis. CLERK: Bruce Watson.

Chairman Clary called the meeting to order and Clerk Watson gave the invocation.

Commissioner Dwight made the motion to approve the minutes of the October 31, 2005 meeting as received. Chairman Clary made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

Commissioner Dwight made the motion to accept the Income and Expense Statements as information. Chairman Clary made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

Under Manager's Report.

Manager Ellis informed the Commissioners that the BPW would spend \$80,000.00 for the engineering work necessary for the relocating of utilities for the 301 Widening Project. He said the project would be done in phases. Manager Ellis explained that the \$80,000.00 would be reimbursed to the BPW from the project's funds.

Manager Ellis informed the Commissioners that the SCDOT had agreed to pay for the relocating of all the utilities affected by the 301 Widening Project. He said the total costs for relocating the utilities would be around one million dollars.

Chairman Clary asked if the BPW would be upgrading their system during the relocation process?

Manager Ellis said they would be upgrading during the relocating of utilities and went on to say the BPW was presently upgrading their system and relocating poles to allow for the widening project at the same time.

Chairman Clary asked if the buildings south of Elm Street would be demolished during the 301 Widening Project? He voiced concerns that the lots needed to be maintained.

Clerk Watson explained that the buildings would be demolished as part of the widening project and that the City may have to force compliance on the lots in question.

With no further announcements or questions from the press, the meeting was adjourned at 5:24 p.m.
