

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BAMBERG BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS ON MONDAY, MARCH 28, 2005 AT 5:15 P.M. AT CITY HALL. MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Bob Clary. Chairman Clary informed the Commissioners that the meeting would be rather short since Manager Ellis was at home sick with the flu.
