

SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL ON THURSDAY, JUNE 21, 2007 AT 5:30 P.M. AT CITY HALL. MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Alton McCollum. COUNCILPERSONS: Buddy Sandifer, Ella Bamberg, Teresa Hannibal, and Nancy Foster. CLERK: Bruce Watson. VISITORS: Phyllis Overstreet.

Mayor McCollum called the meeting to order and Councilperson Foster gave the invocation.

Mayor McCollum began the public hearing to receive comments from the public on proposed Ordinance 07-4 which sets the 2007-2008 budget and millage for the 2007 year.

There were no citizens present and therefore no questions were asked. Mayor McCollum brought the public hearing to a close.

Councilman Sandifer made the motion to approve on first reading Ordinance 07-4 to set the 2007-2008 budget at \$1,900,964.00 and the millage for 2007 at 107.75 mills. Councilperson Foster made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

Council tabled the discussion of issues for the Sanitation Department since Commissioner Fralick was not present.

Councilperson Foster made the motion to go into executive session to discuss the continued employment of an employee. Councilperson Hannibal made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

Councilman Sandifer made the motion to come out of the executive session. Councilperson Foster made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

During the announcements, Councilman Sandifer informed Council that a memorial service for the nine firemen who lost their lives in Charleston this week would be held by the Bamberg Fire Department at 7:15 p.m. tonight. He invited everyone to the memorial service.

With no further business, Councilman Sandifer made the motion to adjourn. Councilperson Foster made the second. All approved. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
