

SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL ON MONDAY, MARCH 31, 2003 AT 12:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL. MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Alton McCollum. COUNCILPERSONS: Buddy Sandifer, Frances Johnson, David Walker, Betty Wells, Betty Mack, and Nancy Foster. CLERK: Bruce Watson.

He explained that SCDOT Officials would be presenting the 301 Widening Plan to concerned property owners and business owners at the National Guard Armory from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Mayor McCollum also informed Council that a party interested in the USA Enterprise Building would also be in town the same day to look over the building.

With no further business, Mrs. Johnson made the motion to adjourn. Mrs. Mack made the second. All approved. The motion carried.
